DIY: Plantable Seed Paper

- **Materials:** Newspaper ads, wildflowers seeds, blue and green food coloring, bowl, water
- **Steps:** Tear newspaper into small pieces. Put pieces of paper in a bowl and pour in water. Let soak for 5 minutes. Rip paper into smaller pieces. It doesn't have to be pulp, just small pieces. Drain most of the water and add wildflower seeds. Mix paper and seeds together. Separate paper into two bowls. Dye some green and some blue. Squeeze out excess water. Separate the colored paper into small batches on a plate for shaping. Press the extra water out. Shape into flat circles. Lay the seed paper out in the sun to dry. Once dry, plant them in loose soil.
